

OKLAHOMA'S PROMISE (OHLAP)

The Oklahoma's Promise Program (OHLAP) has been available to students since 1992. The program provides residents tuition for courses needed to complete a degree or program within five years from award.

To be eligible students must:

- Be a resident of Oklahoma,
- Make a commitment to the program as an 8th, 9th or 10th grade student,
- Attend school regularly,
- Stay away from drugs and alcohol,
- Don't commit criminal or delinquent acts,
- Complete the courses required for admission to any Oklahoma college or university plus 1 unit (these courses must include 2 units of foreign language or technology, and 1 unit of fine arts),
- Graduate with a 2.5 cumulative grade point average and 2.5 core CPA within the previous three years,
- Apply for other financial aid during your senior year of high school.
- Have a family income of \$50,000 or less,
- Have been admitted and enrolled in an institution of higher education or postsecondary career-tech program.
