Our department works to address the variety of educational needs of Mvskoke citizens. The Special Academic/Extra-Curricular/Activities Grant is administered to support this goal.

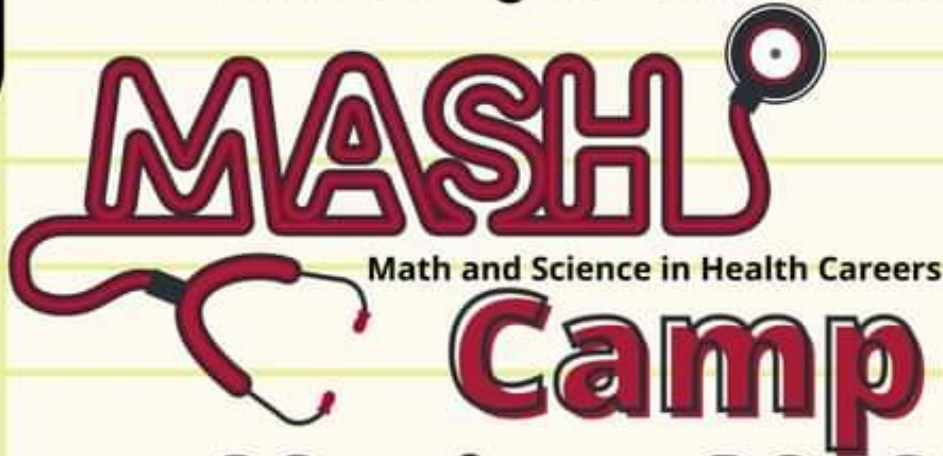
