

Berryhill Elementary Return to School Plan

Masks/Shield/Lanyards

Employees will be required to wear a mask while inside the building.

Students in grades 4-6 will be required to wear masks. Students PreK-3 are encouraged to wear masks but they will not be required. Students may take masks off while on outside recess or during outside PE. Students will be provided with one lanyard that will stay at school to help them keep up with their mask. *Wearing of masks will be revisited periodically at the district level as CDC, state, and county guidelines change.*

Meet The Teacher

Meet the Teacher will be similar to supply pick up in the spring. Teachers and assistants will be in the loops. Parents and students will drive through and drop their supplies off. We will notify parents before this date as to who their child’s homeroom teacher will be. Supplies should be in paper sacks with each child’s name on the sack.

All students PK-6th will be expected to use the loop the first day of school. No parents will be allowed to walk their child into the building.

Visitors/Guests

Only essential visitors or guests will be allowed on campus and must be approved by the building principal. Visitors must check in at the office of each building with the secretary and record temperature and answer questionnaires

Before School

- 7:15-7:30 K-6th drop off in the South Loop
- 7:30-7:55 K-3 drop off in South Loop
- 7:30-7:50 4-6th students **eating breakfast** drop off at South Loop
- 7:30-7:55 4-6th drop off in North Loop (non-breakfast eaters)

SE students will eat breakfast in the cafeteria as normal.
 NE students will be served a “Grab and Go” breakfast and take to the NE to eat.

PE/Music/Band

PE will either be held outside or in the gym. If PE is held outside they will be allowed to take their mask off. Students will clip their mask to their lanyard. Anytime they take the mask off it will be put inside their shirt to avoid contacting surfaces. If PE is held inside, each student will have their own 6’ square in the gym. Students will be required to wear their mask while having PE inside.

Music will be held in the music room with students practicing social distancing and wearing their masks.

In 6th Grade Band students will still be learning to play an instrument. Students will be socially distanced as much as possible.

Lunch Schedule - No visitors during lunch.

In the cafeteria students will sit 2 students per table all on the same side. Each grade will alternate sides of the tables to allow for cleaning. Students will have assigned seats by Teacher and student number. Cafeteria tables will be labeled. Students will wear their mask until they get to their assigned seat. At that time they will use their lanyard and place their mask inside their shirt.

After School

K students will be picked up in the K Loop

1-3 students will be picked up in the SE Loop. Car riders will wait in the cafeteria.

4-6 students will be picked up in the NE Loop

No NE students will come to the SE to be picked up

No SE or NE students will come to the K loop to be picked up

End of the Day Release Times for car riders. Bus riders will release at regular times. Bus drivers will do their best to sit families together and have assigned seats for bus riders.

Live class sessions will be held via Zoom and recorded for students to view at a later time. Zoom will also be used for live/recorded teaching lessons.
