Draw 3 things that begin with the letter /U/.	Watch Jack Hartmann "3-D Shapes" on youtube.	Draw a picture of a fruit or vegetable and color it.	Move small items from one cup/bowl to another cup/bowl using the hand you write with.	Make a rubbed art picture. Use a crayon/pencil and a piece of paper. Put the item under it and color on top until you see the imprint of the item...like a leaf.
Introduce the letter /Q/ and the sound it makes. Think of words that begin with /Q/.	Count all of the chairs in your house.	Go on a nature walk in your back yard and see what all you can find.	Form letters in the air with your finger.	Go on a bear hunt in your neighborhood with your family.

Practice ABC flash cards.	Watch Jack Hartmann, "Subitize Country Style" on youtube.	Practice The Pledge of Allegiance.	Color a page in a coloring book.	Practice tying your shoes.
