Watch ABC Mouse and Jack Hartmann for letters /J/ and /Z/.	Separate Legos by color and see what color you have the most of.	Curl up like an egg, crawl like a caterpillar, be as still as a chrysalis and fly like a butterfly.	Draw and color a butterfly.	Help set the table for dinner.
Practice ABC flash cards.	Watch Jack Hartmann, "Calendar Song/Springtime Dance" on youtube.	Practice The Pledge of Allegiance.	Write your name 5 times.	Practice tying your shoes.
